Management of the fearful dental patient frequently presents a challenge. In this program Dr. Malamed will discuss routes of administration of sedative drugs, including oral, intravenous, intranasal, intramuscular and inhalation.

Recommendations for the safe and effective use of these drugs and techniques will be given. Complications associated with drug administration, their prevention, recognition and management, will also be reviewed.

Stanley F. Malamed, DDS

Dr. Malamed was born and raised in the Bronx, NY, graduating from the New York University College of Dentistry in 1959. He completed a dental internship and residency in anesthesiology at Montefiore Hospital and Medical Center in the Bronx before serving for two years in the U.S. Army Dental Corps at Ft. Knox. In 1973, Dr. Malamed joined the faculty of the USC School of Dentistry, in Los Angeles, where today he is Professor of Anesthesia & Medicine. Dr. Malamed

is a Diplomate of the American Dental Board of Anesthesiology, and a recipient of the Heidebrink Award from the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology and the Horace Wells Award from the International Federation of Dental Anesthesia Societies.

Dr. Malamed has authored more than 120 scientific papers and 16 chapters in various medical and dental journals and textbooks in the areas of physical evaluation, emergency medicine, local anesthesia, sedation and general anesthesia. He is the author of three widely used textbooks, published by CV Mosby: *Handbook of Medical Emergencies in the Dental Office*; *Handbook of Local Anesthesia*; *Sedation - A Guide to Patient Management* and two interactive DVD's: *Emergency Medicine* and *Malamed's Local Anesthetic Technique*.

In his spare time, Dr. Malamed is an avid runner, exercise enthusiast, and admits an addiction to the New York Times crossword puzzle.
